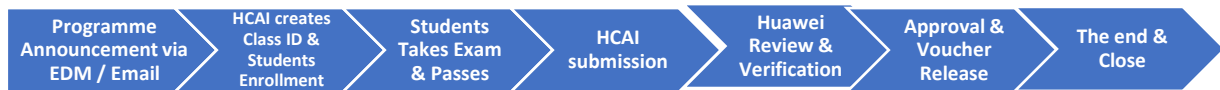

3. Elite Club calculation interval will be by quarterly basis, whereby each cycle’s calculation cut-off date will be on **30th June, 30th September and 31st December 2022 respectively.**
4. Cut off dates for claim form submission will be **25th June, 25th September and 25th December 2022.** No claim form will be entertained after cut-off date.
5. All rewards will be delivered after cut-off date of each quarter.
6. Any unclaimed certificate over Year 2022 will be forfeited.
7. All duplicate submissions, fraud or false information submitted will be disqualified.
8. Rebate will be in the form of gift voucher subject to availability. All vouchers are not transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash.

Category

A) Active Students

1. Must be active and valid Huawei ICT Academy in Malaysia.
2. All students’ user ID must be associated with academy
3. More than 150 students who have learned at least 1 chapter or passed mock exam of any Huawei courses in Talent Online Platform.
4. Limited to **first 15** who meets the requirements and it is **first come first serve basis.**

Supporting Documents:

- Name list of students in excel file. The name list must consists of students’ user ID, full name, course name, learning progress and or/ mock exam results.

B) Huawei Career Certifications

1. Possesses Huawei Certified Academy Instructors (HCAI) qualification and successfully trained a student
2. The student passes the exam and obtained HCIA and or HCIP certification between 1st January to 31st December 2022 are eligible to claim the incentive.
3. HCAI creates a Class Code at Huawei Talent Online platform and students enrolled the class created by the HCAI.

Supporting Documents:

- HCAI is required to screen shot the Class Code which was created in Talent Online platform.
- HCAI is required to obtain agreement and request the certificate (softcopy) from the students on his/her own and submits the claim together with the certificates.

C) Open Class

1. HCAI who opens a class with each 50 students' enrollments and all students must passed mock exam in Huawei Talent Online platform.
2. Each user ID of students will only be counted one enrollment. If one student has enrolled in multiple different classes, it will be counted as one enrollment only.

Supporting Documents

- Full screenshot of the class code(s)
- Students enrollment name list in excel file
- Summary report which is generated from the class report with mock exam results in excel file
- Attendance Report or after training evaluation survey report (either one)

D) Activity

1. Administrator, HCAI, lecturers or staff of the academy (must have Talent Online Account and associated with the academy) is eligible to claim if the requirement is met.
2. Huawei ICT Academy Club with minimum 100 members of students.
3. Huawei ICT Academy Club information or page is published in University Student government (group) / Official website/Social media or etc.
4. Organises at least 2 activities for the members in 2022. The activities include but not limited to competition, students' sharing, workshop and any other activities which is related and promoting the club.
5. Limited to **first 5 Huawei ICT Academies** who met the requirements and it is on **first come first serve basis**.
